The Green Register celebrates 25 years this Autumn. To mark this momentous occasion, we will be hosting an exhibition showcasing the work of The Green Register and our members.

This will take place 23rd October to 12th November 2025 at our base, The Create Centre in Bristol. We also plan to create a virtual version of the exhibition that will run online concurrently to reach a wider audience.

Materials for the exhibition

The Green Register will be very pleased to include examples of your sustainable design, consultancy or specialist services and building work in our exhibition.

We've created a [Google form](#) to collect all the information we require to create an exhibit of your work, including accompanying images/videos/details of models etc to illustrate the project.

This summary sheet, which gives details of all the information requested on the form, will help you get everything you need together beforehand hopefully making the form easy to complete and submit.

There is limited capacity within our exhibition space and inclusion cannot be guaranteed. Entries will be considered for selection upon receipt; therefore, early submission is strongly encouraged.

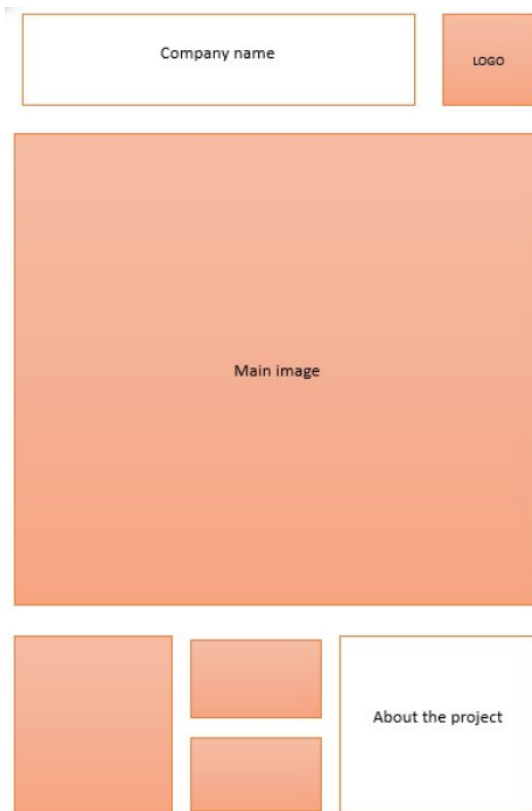

Materials to illustrate your project

We will create a printed board showing your project, including a selection of images (if provided) and a text information panel – example layout shown below.



The requirements for different types of materials to illustrate your project are given below.

The form includes links to submit images and videos at the same time as submitting the form. Even if you are not able to upload these at the time, we ask you to indicate which type of materials you would like to submit – i.e. images/video/model/other.

Images - What to submit

Please provide up to 6 images of your sustainable construction project in one of the formats listed below.

The images should ideally illustrate the progress of the project plus any special features, low-carbon methodologies or materials. Plans, CAD drawings, energy modelling images are welcome too.

Please number your images in the order that they should appear on the printed board - see example layout above.

- **Image format:** PNG, PDG, TIFF
- **File size:** Minimum 2 MB, preferably larger
- **Resolution:** 300 dpi minimum

Videos - What to submit

Perhaps a video tells the story of your sustainable building project better? Your film could include an introduction to the brief, interviews with the project team and client, footage of the construction process and discussion around challenges and solutions.

Your video will either be displayed via a screen in the exhibition space or projected onto a wall.

- **Video format:** MP4 (H.264)
- **Length:** 2-5 minutes

Models - What to submit

Scale models of sustainable buildings may be less common these days, but fascinating and thought-provoking for exhibition visitors to engage with.

The exhibition space has the following number and sizes of display plinths available on a first-come-first serve basis. Please ensure that your model/3D object will fit on one of these plinths – we ask you to indicate which size plinth will be most suitable:

- 3 plinths sized at 600 x 600mm
- 3 plinths sized at 900 x 600mm
- 3 plinths sized at 1200 x 600mm

Please note: You will need to arrange delivery and collection of all materials to/from The Create Centre in Bristol. This is at your own risk and TGR cannot accept responsibility for any damage caused in transit.

Details of the project illustrated by your submission

Finally, we ask for the following information to help us fully showcase your work:

- Your logo
- Project name
- Design company name
- Build company name
- Consultancy
- Project location
- Project completion date
- Budget (if available)
- Project brief, up to 200 words - Reason for build, client wishlist etc.
- Sustainability features – materials, kit, methodology (e.g EnerPhit, Passivhaus), modelling used (e.g. WUFI, PHPP), reuse features (e.g. salvaged materials, reused materials from original building)
- A URL for your chosen website landing page to allow visitors to connect with you - we will create a QR code to add to the printed display board or display alongside your exhibit
- Your contact details - in case we have any queries about your submission.
